

Camp Logistics

If you are attending Camp Creative for the first time, please don't hesitate to ask any Camp committee member or look out for our colourful 'Guides' for help. We want you to feel at home at the Camp so that your experience at Camp Creative will be enjoyable.

Venues

Bellingen High School and Bellingen Primary School are the two main campuses. View maps on page 21 and 22.

Some courses are located in venues around Bellingen. These are marked on the town map on page 24.

Evening events are held at Stockton Hall at Bellingen High School or as listed under each event on page 10.

Both schools are smoke-free zones.

There is no wifi available at any of the Camp venues.

Course Hours

All courses run over five days, from Monday morning January 13, to Friday afternoon January 17.

Full-day courses

Start at 9.00 am and finish at around 4.00 pm.



Half-day courses

Morning courses run 9.00 am to 12.00 pm

Afternoon courses run 1.00 pm to 4.00 pm

Check-in

Check-in is at Bellingen High School, Sunday January 12 between 10.00 am and 4.00 pm at Stockton Hall (please see map on page 22).

You'll receive your name tag, copy of this guide and be directed to your classroom or town venue. Camp volunteers will also be available to

answer questions if required.

The Camp Offices also have large scale campus maps. Your classroom will be marked with a sign.

If you are unable to check-in on Sunday, the High School is open from 8.00 am on Monday morning.

It is very hectic at this time, so it is best to arrive early. Sunday check-in is always the best option.

Guides

Need some directions or a helping hand? The friendly young Guides are keen to help you out. Look for the bright green shirts – they're usually found at the Camp Office.

Name badge

Your course tutor and classmates might take a while to get to know your name – it helps if you can wear your name badge each day. It is also used for entry to Camp events.

Daily bulletin

Each day you'll get an update of all things Camp Creative – you'll find them in your classroom or on noticeboards around the Camp. Contact the Camp Office by 3.00 pm if you'd like to add items to the bulletin.

Materials

If you're in an art class and need some extra supplies or to fill a gap on your materials list, you can order art supplies via Gail Cardow at Island Art Supplies. She has an order sheet at the Camp office and makes deliveries each day.

You can also head down to Weave on the main street of Bellingin, who have a great range of artists' supplies and craft equipment and materials.

Photocopying

If you need photocopying or printing, head to the Camp Office and for a small fee our Guides will copy for you.

Lost Property

If you find any lost property, please bring it to the Camp Office for collection by the owners.

Security

We suggest that you take home any valuable equipment after your class has finished for the day. Classrooms are locked overnight and security is provided, but we can't cover the loss of any Camper's items.

Accessibility

The majority of our venues meet accessibility standards, and we are focused on making the

Kids & Teens

We want your kids to have lots of fun! We also want to them to have a safe and friendly experience, so we have some guidelines in place.

Outside of class times, children under fifteen are considered to be under the care of their parents. However, for kids under ten, we have specific requirements.

You will have received an online form via email before the Camp to provide the information and permissions requested below. If you haven't returned the online form, you can use the form enclosed in this Guide. Please return the completed form to the Office on the Monday.

Health & Activity form

All parents and guardians will have been sent an online health and activities form for all kids and teens under 18. This information will be provided to our Camp First Aid team and tutors where required.

Allergies & Medical Conditions

Please ensure any allergies or medical conditions are noted on the Health & Activity form.

We encourage the provision of allergy or asthma management plans. These must be provided to the Camp Office, who will then provide a copy to class tutors. We do not manage medications or provide pain relief. Sign-in & Out

All kids under 10 must be signed in AND out of their classrooms everyday by a parent or guardian aged over 18 years.

Kids will stay in their classroom until they have been signed out.

If a child is collected from a class before the class finish time, the tutor MUST be notified and the child MUST be signed out.

Lunchtime

All kids under 10, who will not be spending lunch time with their families at the High School and Primary School have a lunchroom space, with supervised play area. Kids can be signed up for this lunchtime service at the Camp Office, or via the online registration form on the Camp website.

All kids under 12 participating in courses at the Youth Hub must have permission from their parents to leave the Hub during lunchtime. Please confirm this on either the online or enclosed form.

Photos & Video

Please let us know if you would prefer that your child not be included in official Camp photos and video.

We do use them for Camp publicity, so they may appear on our website, social media and promotional materials. Kids and teens who cannot be included will have a coloured sticker on their name badge to notify photography and video teams. Please ensure they wear their name badge at all times.

Health & Safety

Safe Work, Safe Classrooms

Safety is a high priority for Camp Creative — for all Campers, tutors, staff and volunteers.

You'll get a safety induction from your tutor first thing Monday morning. They'll also provide ongoing demonstrations and information around work safety throughout the week.

We ask that you respect all guidelines around safety and wear the appropriate clothing, footwear and protective gear as required.

Beat the heat

Bellingen is very hot in January, which can affect your health. Wear cool, loose clothing and if outside, sunscreen and a hat. Drink plenty of water and spend time in air-conditioning whenever you can.

There may still be smoke around from recent bushfires, so it is a good idea to stay indoors in classrooms on any smoky days. Those doing outdoor courses may wish to take lunch breaks inside air-conditioned rooms.

Bushfires

We have every precaution in place around bushfire safety. We will be in communication with local fire authorities during the week. We have a complete plan in place and will promptly communicate any actions Campers may need to undertake around fire safety. These will be both within and outside of official class hours.

Please rely on our formal communications or those through official channels such as the Rural Fire Service and ABC Coffs Coast radio 92.3 FM. Recent experience has proven that word of mouth and social media are not the best sources of information and can create unnecessary concern.

Be Eco-Friendly

Water Use

Bellingen is incredibly low on water and during the Camp week, will be either at Level Four, or possibly Emergency Water restrictions.

It is crucially important that every Camper, no matter where they are staying, do their utmost to reduce their water use.

- ✔ Use your phone to set a timer for a three-minute shower — and don't have baths.
- ✔ Cool down in the Bellingen Pool or the ocean at Urunga.
- ✔ If you're washing your clothes, do a big load all at once.
- ✔ At your accommodation, do the mellow yellow toilet flush (you know what we mean!)
- ✔ Please don't wash your car, caravan or motorhome.

If you're staying at serviced accommodation:

- ✔ Re-use your towels for the whole week
- ✔ Ask that your bed linen not be changed

Bring Your Own

Want to help reduce waste? Bring along your reusable kit everyday — coffee cup, water bottle, cutlery and straw. We've got water filling stations and the High School café gives a 50c discount on any hot drink if you bring your reusable cup.

Scraps for chooks!

Look out for the different types of bins at the High School and Primary School campuses.

You'll need to sort your recycling, but you can also now put food waste in special bins. They'll go to the chooks at the High School and the worms and compost at the Primary School.

Airconditioning

Most of our classes are airconditioned — a big reprieve from the January heat! Help keep the energy use down and prevent them from overloading by keeping doors shut, especially during break and lunch periods.

Getting around

Parking

High School Parking

Front Entrance

The primary car park is in the front entrance on the Waterfall Way. There is no parking at the top level near the administration block.

Rear Entrance

The bridge from the Crown Street bus stop is currently under construction and closed to pedestrians. If you use this car park you can hop on the shuttle bus to get to the rear entrance.

The Camp bus stop is now in the rear car park off Crown Street. Parking here will be very limited.

Disabled parking

A valet disabled parking service is available at the High School. Camp staff can meet your car at the top drop-off zone and park it at the bottom. Your keys will be kept in secure storage at the Camp Office. Your car will be driven up for you to collect when you require it. Please call Rob Stockton on 0403227599 to organise this service.

Primary School

Unlimited street parking is available on William and Lovell Streets, and nearby side streets. The teacher's car park is closed to Campers, with the exception of disabled parking.

Town

Bellingham has had an increase in parking zones in recent years — previous secret spots may now have time limits. Watch out for limits on side streets immediately off Hyde Street.

Camp Shuttle Bus

The Camp Shuttle bus runs mornings, lunchtimes and afternoons daily. It runs in a CLOCKWISE loop through the town. Each loop runs in fifteen-minute intervals.

The main stops are the Showground on the North Side, the High School and the Primary School. Additional town stops are marked on the bus map.

One bus is fitted for wheelchair access, the other with a ramp. Please call Rob Stockton on 0403227599 to organise the right bus for your pick-up.

Morning loop

Starts from Showground at 8.00 am, departing in fifteen-minute intervals until 8.45 am.

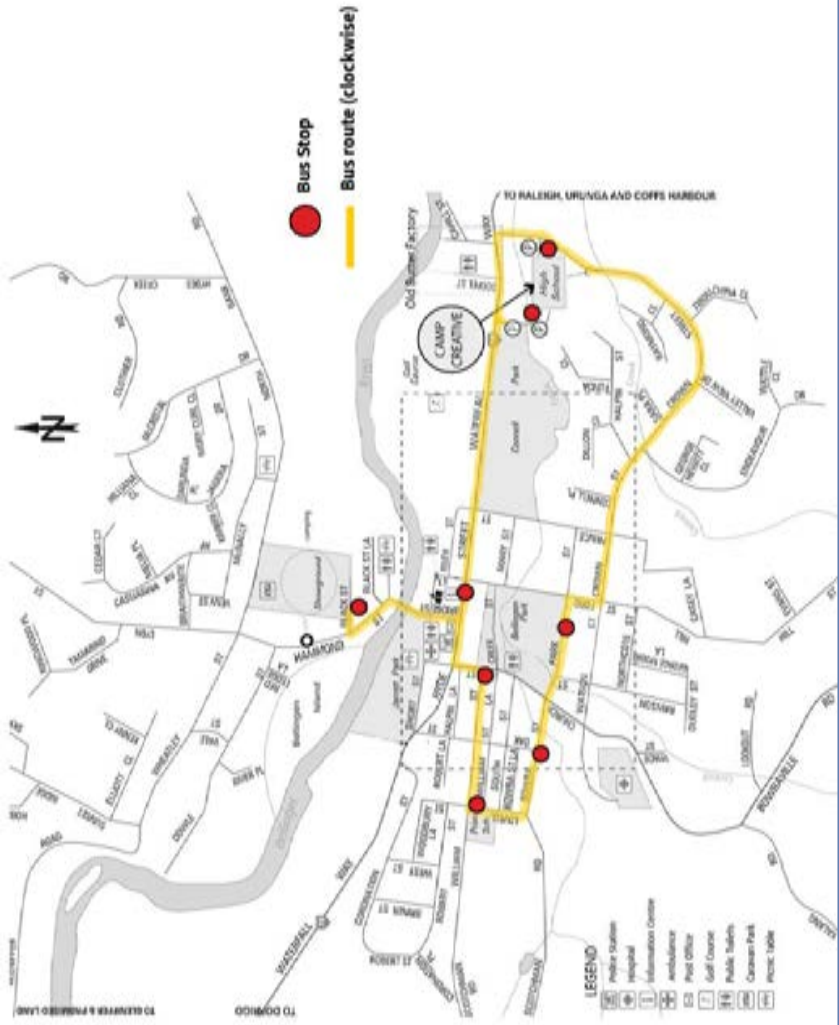
Lunch Shuttle

Quirky Bello

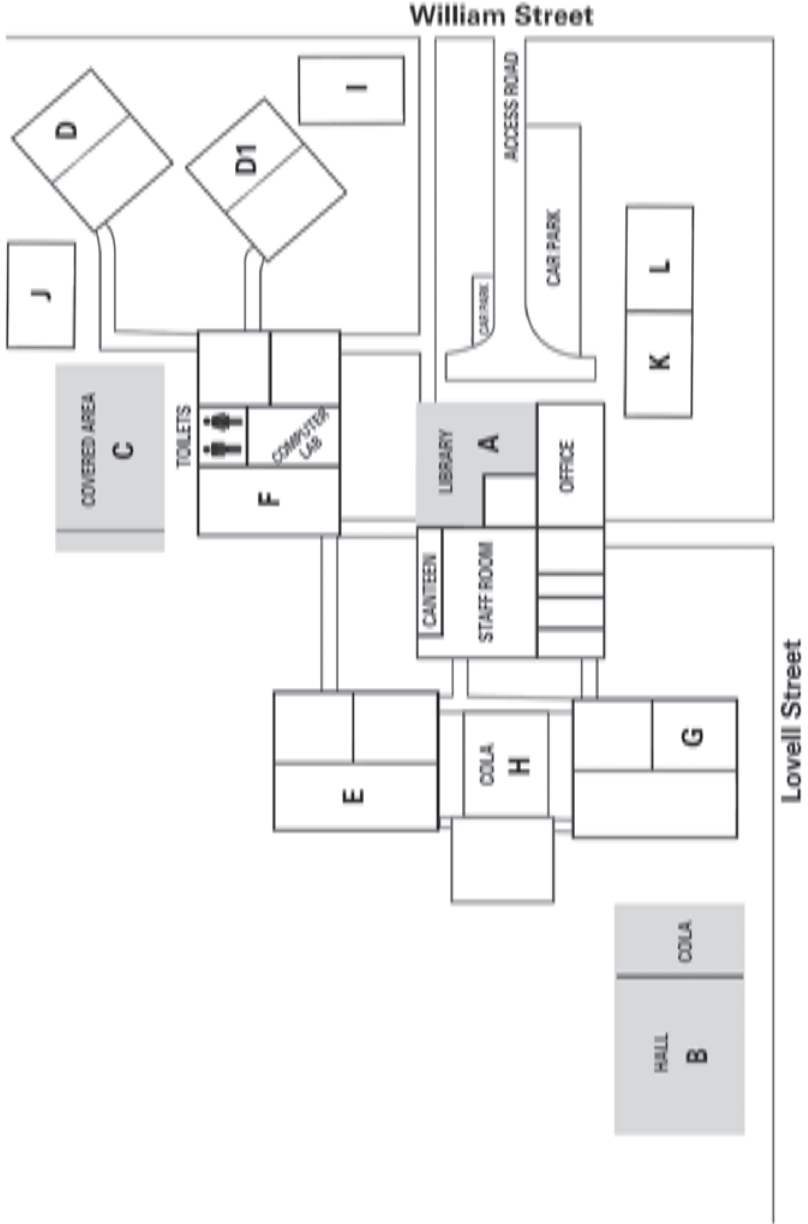

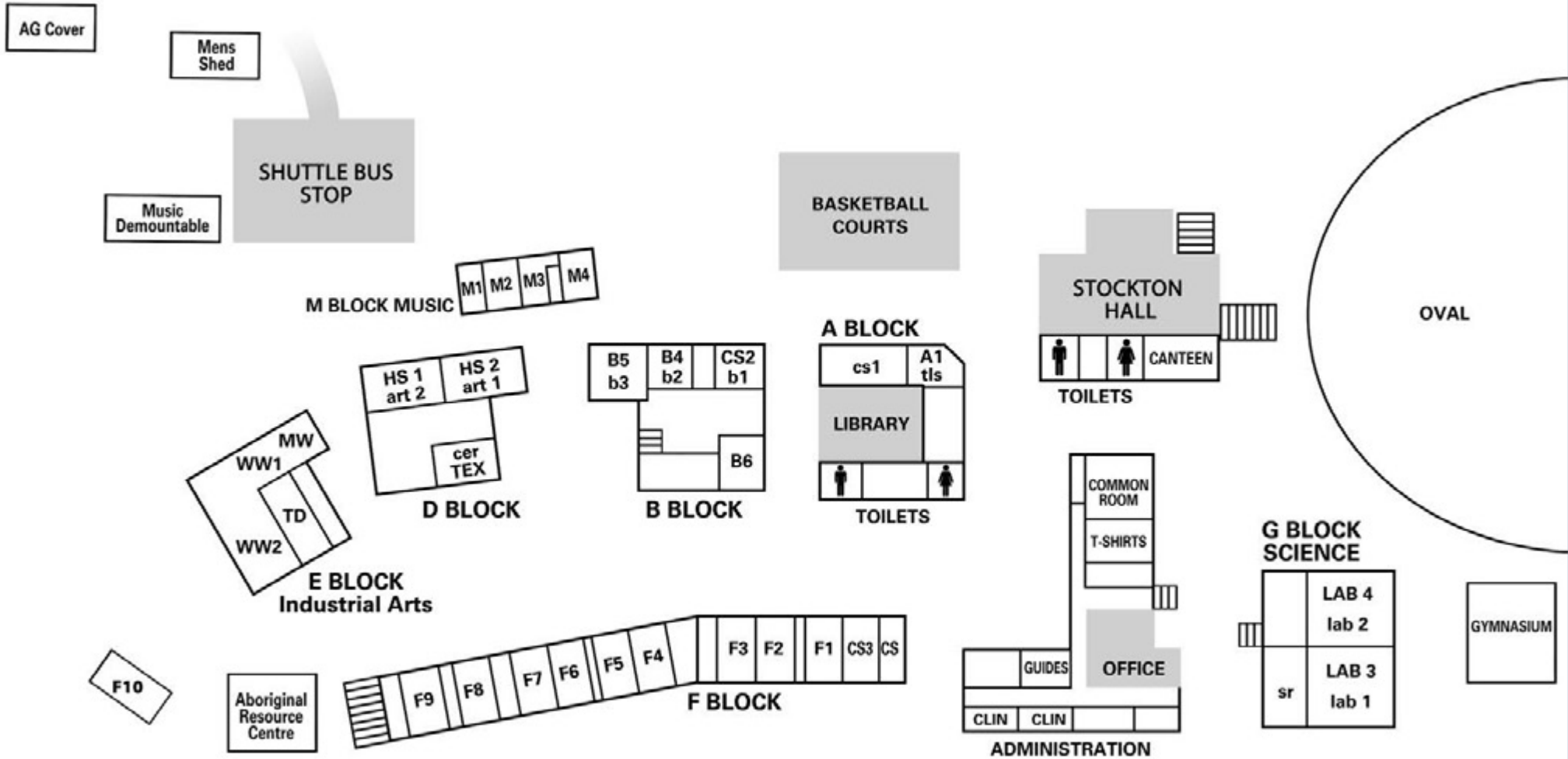

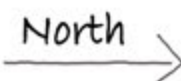
